

**Town Board Meeting – November 20, 2025 – Following Special Town meeting  
6:45pm – Town of Lisbon Hall**

**Call to order** – The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Kevin Klinker. Also present were Kevin Wetley, Jeff Keating, Jeff Johnson and clerk, Andrea Hawkins.

**Verification of Public Notice** – The meeting was properly posted on 11/18/25.

**Minutes** – Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to approve the October 2025 minutes as read. Motion carried.

**Public Comment** – None.

**Zoning Report** – No permits issued.

**Road Report** – Lynxx is working in the Town of Lindina and are now crossing over into the Town of Lisbon. They didn't originally realize it was in the Town of Lisbon. Lynxx provided maps to the Town Board. Hawkins will prepare a permit for them to sign outlining the restrictions the Town has as well as letting them know there is a buried water line on Niles Rd. They can contact Johnson when they are working on that road so he can make them aware of where the line is. Johnson patched some of the washed-out spots on Duckworth Rd. Johnson also did some shouldering including on Welch Prairie where it was recently patched over the culvert. Culvert markers were ordered and Babcock will start installing. Anderson will do some mowing once he's available. **Discuss/Approve new signs to be installed at the corner of Bridge St (State Hwy 80) & Frontage Rd notifying truck traffic of upcoming weight limits** – Johnson noted that we will need to see where the signs can be placed to avoid blocking the view coming off of Germantown Rd.

**Chairman's Report – Review resume of applicant interested in snowplow position** – Resume was reviewed and it was recommended that if he is still interested once Klinker calls him back to explain what it would entail that he would need to ride with Jeff. Rick Barrett called and spoke with Klinker asking if he could smooth out the berm along the ditch. He informed Barrett that he is allowed to clean out the ditch and keep the spoils. The Town is not responsible for anything done off the right of way.

**Review/approve new Election Hardware Maintenance Agreement w/ Command Central** – Motion by Wetley, second by Keating to approve the agreement. Motion carried.

**Approve 2026 Town Budget** – Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to approve the 2026 Town Budget. Motion carried.

**Clerk's report** – October bank statements and cash account balances as per general ledger were reviewed by the Board. Budget comparisons were made. Motion by Wetley, second by Keating to approve checks 7716-7732 as per disbursement journal. Motion carried.

**Adjourn** – Motion by Keating, second by Klinker to adjourn meeting. Meeting adjourned. 8:00pm.
