

**Town Board Meeting – September 18, 2025 – 7:00 pm – Town of Lisbon Hall**

**Call to Order** – The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Kevin Klinker. Also present were Kevin Wetley, Jeff Keating, Karl & Kim Kannenberg & clerk, Andrea Hawkins.

**Verification of Public Notice** – The meeting was properly posted on September 15, 2025.

**Minutes** – Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to approve the August 2025 minutes as read. Motion carried.

**Public Comment – Kannenberg – Culvert Concerns** – Karl expressed his concerns regarding the culverts not being low enough to drain water out of his fields. Klinker explained that the culvert is at the correct depth and it is simply an equalizing culvert. It also cannot be any larger. The ditch in both directions go up hill and drain tile would need to be added to address getting the water away from his field. The board informed him of the process of getting the wetland determination done as well as him collaborating with the neighboring farmers. There is nothing more the Town can do. Kannenberg also noted that there is a tree near the road that should be removed.

**Amos Schrock – Potential plans for mobile home park on Cty B** – He did not attend the meeting.

**Road Report** – Keating received the bridge inspection on the McEwen Rd Bridge from the county. At this time there is no funding available to do any improvements because it isn't in bad enough condition. The county said that nothing needs to be done at this time. **Review/Approve quote from Bolligs for sand** – Motion by Wetley, seconded by Keating to approve the quote for sand. Motion carried.

**Zoning Report** – 3 Permits were issued – Lee (Shelter for saw mill), Cowan (new home), SBA (updates to tower).

**Chairman's Report** – Klinker talked to Brian Bell about potential options for snow plowing. He suggested 2 people that might be interested.

**Sign DOT Map – Verify local road mileage** – Map was reviewed by board. Only change was on Germantown Rd due to the City of New Lisbon annexing property along that road. Klinker signed the map to approve the mileage.

**Review/Approve request from Alliant Energy for ROW work on 42<sup>nd</sup> St.** – Motion by Keating, second by Klinker to approve the work as per the specs provided. Motion carried.

**Clerk's report** – August bank statements and cash account balances as per general ledger were reviewed by the Board. Budget comparisons were made. Motion by Wetley, second by Keating to approve checks 7677-7699 as per disbursement journal. Motion carried.

**Adjourn** – Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to adjourn meeting. Meeting adjourned. 8:00pm.
