

Town Board Meeting – April 23, 2026 – Following the Annual Meeting – Town of Lisbon Hall

Call to order – The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Kevin Klinker. Also present were Kevin Wetley, Jeff Keating, Mitchell Seitz, Jeff Johnson, Brian Bires & clerk, Andrea Hawkins.

Verification of public notice – The meeting was properly posted on 4/21/26.

Minutes – Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to approve the March 2026 minutes as read, motion carried.

Public comment – Bires noted that near his driveway at N4941 Felland Rd, the gravel along the road keeps getting washed away when it rains and is started to erode the road edge. Seitz will refill and add a blacktop trough for the water to flow down.

Zoning Report – The following permits were issued: W6683 Welch Prairie – home addition, N5304 Hwy 12 & 16 – garage, N5870 Hwy 12 & 16 – detached sunroom

Road Report – Concrete culvert on 8th Ave needs some repairs. The road bans are now off. Some patching has been completed. Culvert markers have been used to mark the culverts. Culverts were replaced on Niles & Meyer Rd. There is a culvert near N6689 Germantown Rd that needs to be replaced. The culvert on Johnson Rd will be replaced when the drain tile project is being done. The following roads will be sealcoated: Frontage, 12th, 42nd, Welch Prairie #1, Meyer Rd #2, #5, #6 & part of #7 closest to the city.

Chairman's Report – Klinker noted that the road review was completed and that he would finish notes and give to Hawkins.

Review/Approve Resolution 2026-02 – Resolution supporting a comprehensive and sustainable transportation funding solution – Motion by Wetley, second by Keating to approve Resolution 2026-02. Motion carried.

Reappoint Plan Commission and Board of Appeals members – Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to reappoint Bill Pfaff as Plan Commission Chair and Dwyane Haschke as a Plan Commission member for a term of 5/1/26 – 4/30/29. Motion carried.

Review/Approve Hwy workers' wages – Wage will remain the same.

Clerk's Report – There was discussion about changing the meeting time to earlier in the evening. The board agreed that from here going forward the new meeting time will be 5:30pm. Hawkins will make a note on the Town's website and well as notify the county to have them update it on their website. March bank statements and cash account balances as per general ledger were reviewed by the Board. Budget comparisons were made. Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to approve checks 7815-7833 as per disbursement journal. Motion carried.
