

Town Board Meeting – February 19, 2026 – 7:00pm – Town of Lisbon Hall

Call to Order - The meeting was called to order by chairman, Kevin Klinker. Also present were Kevin Wetley, Jeff Keating, Jeff Johnson, Mitchell Seitz & clerk, Andrea Hawkins. In addition, Steve Bezemek from Scott construction and Fred Brown from Farhner. Also, Bill Sumiec came part way through the meeting.

Verification of public notice – The meeting was properly posted on February 17, 2026.

Minutes – Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to accept the January 2026 minutes as read. Motion carried.

Public Comment – (discussed at the end of the meeting) - Sumiec asked about the wood/brush from trees that were cut. The board noted that it was in the right-of-way and would be cleaned up. The hwy workers found a large chain in the ditch when they were working and Sumiec mentioned at the meeting that it was his. The chain was returned but he was told that he should not leave items like that in the ditch as it could cause damage to the town mower.

Zoning Report – None.

Road Report – Anderson mowed several roads as well as Frontline Forestry did some tree trimming on Johnson Rd. Bolligs did some tree cutting along Duckworth road and the stumps were treated. Seitz will do some more stump treating soon.

Open Sealed bids for Double Seal & Gravel – Bids were opened for seal coat -

Farner Asphalt: \$4.88/gal & %58.60/ton stone

Scott Construction: \$5.21/gal & \$36/ton stone

Motion by Klinker, second by Wetley to approve the contract from Scott Construction.

Review bid/specs for new plow truck – Tabled.

Discuss road bans – will be posted soon.

Chairman's Report – Klinker asked Hawkins to check into road school being offered. See what the topics & what price is.

Hwy aid – matching funds – Motion by Wetley, second by Keating to approve the matching funds agreement. Motion carried.

Clerk's report – Hawkins asked about changing the Clerk/Treasurer position to an appointed position. It would essentially transition the position from elected to "hired" and in the future this would allow for non-town residents to hold the position. It would also allow for more flexibility with changing the pay of the position as well as allowing the Clerk/Treasurer to be at all of the elections (couldn't previously be there if they were on the ballot). The board agreed that it was a good idea and this will be added to the Annual Meeting agenda as it can now be changed during that meeting. January bank statements and cash account balances as per general ledger were reviewed by the Board. Budget comparisons were made. Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to sign checks 7779-7798 as per disbursement journal. Motion carried.
