

Town Board Meeting – March 19, 2026 – 7pm – Town of Lisbon Hall

Call to Order – The meeting was called to order by chairman, Kevin Klinker. Also present were Kevin Wetley, Jeff Keating, Jeff Johnson, Mitchell Seitz, Karl Kannenberg, Kevin Riley & clerk, Andrea Hawkins.

Verification of public notice – The meeting was properly posted on March 17, 2026.

Minutes – Motion by Keating, second by Wetley to accept the February 2026 minutes as read. Motion carried.

Public Comment – None

Zoning Report – Randy Myers called about adding on to his current garage. Since the garage is closer to the road than currently allowed, Hawkins explained to him that he would need a conditional use permit. Klinker also talked to him and suggested that he build a separate garage that meets the setbacks to avoid needing a conditional use permit.

Road Report – The 2005 truck had a new turbo installed and the pulley was replaced on the New Holland.

Chairman's Report – Klinker suggested that we find some other options for road school for Seitz since the one being offered in April doesn't have the content that we need. Hawkins will look for options that have topics that align with what we need.

Review/Approve possible cost share drainage improvement on Johnson Rd –

There continues to be drainage issues near Johnson road that nearby farmers (Kannenberg & Riley) would like to address. Riley would like to put drain tile in his field. He would also be willing to install a French drain to help drain the water away from the road if the town would be willing to help with the cost. There would also be additional cost of increasing the size of the drain tile to accommodate the extra water from the French drain. Kannenberg would also share in the cost since this would also benefit his land on the opposite side of the road. Motion by Keating, second by Wetley for the Town to pay for the cost of the new culvert, gravel, extra cost for increased tile size and French drains, not to exceed \$5,000.

Curran, Hollenbeck & Orton – Legal Retainer 4/1/26 – 3/31/27 – Motion by Wetley, second by Keating to approve Resolution 2026-01 to retain William Curran as legal counsel. Motion carried.

Review/Approve Proposal from Ever Green Landscaping to continue maintaining Town Hall/Shop lawn – Motion by Keating, second by Klinker to approve the proposal. Motion carried.

Schedule Road Inspection Meeting – To be determined but will not include the entire Town Board.

Clerk's report – February bank statements and cash account balances as per general ledger were reviewed by the Board. Budget comparisons were made. Motion by Wetley, second by Keating to approve checks 7799 (void) 7800 – 7814 as per disbursement journal.

The Annual meeting will be held at 6:30pm on April 23, 2026 prior to the regular monthly board meeting.
